**Child Steps International** is seeking a **Monitoring, Evaluation, and Learning Director (ME&L)** for an anticipated USAID-funded project in Liberia. This project, "Liberia Accountability and Voice Initiative" (LAVI) is to strengthen multi-stakeholder partnerships to advocate for and monitor policy and accountability reforms in Liberia, which will increase the influence of citizens and media in the governance of public goods and services.

## The Monitoring, Evaluation and Learning Director will:

- Provide performance monitoring and evaluation of the project to include developing appropriate indicators, implementing systems to safeguard the collection and management of program data, and recommending changes to performance monitoring and work plans.
- Provide technical assistance and training to project staff and liaise with USAID/Liberia in ME&L design, modification and reporting.
